Who needs to Register?

An employer is an individual, partnership, company or trust employing workers including apprentices and casuals:

- For 3 or more days in any month (of no less than 5 hours per day), under a contract of service in the construction industry;
- Who work predominantly on-site;
- In a classification of work referred to in one of the prescribed awards.

Voluntary Registration

Employers may voluntarily register workers in the scheme who work off-site in any classification in the Fibrous Plasterers (Factory) Award or as a Carpenter, Joiner, Tradesperson, Machinist, Terrazzo Assistant, Factory Hand or Adult Trainee—Terrazzo Worker (ist 6 months) in the National Joinery and Building Trades Product Award 1993 (and were previously paid under the Terrazzo & Concrete Casting Award).

Construction industry work covers work on new or existing commercial, industrial or domestic buildings or structures.

The Act does not apply to employment:

- By the Crown or an agency or instrumentality of the Crown
- By a council
- Where the worker carries out construction work on premises owned or occupied by their employer (not being premises intended for subsequent sale or lease) and that is the sole construction work in which the worker is engaged by that employer.
